TOURNAMENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

Eligibility: As this event is a State Championship all entrants are required to:

(i) comply with NSW residency criteria; i.e. must be a NSW resident and have been permanently domiciled in the State of NSW for a minimum period of six (6) months immediately prior to this event;

(ii) not have previously competed in another State Championship of the same discipline (i.e. snooker) in the same calendar year.

- All players must be financial members of Snooker & Billiards NSW for the current financial year
- Tournament will be conducted under the Rules of Play & Code of Ethics as contained in the Australian Billiards & Snooker Council Handbook (and amendments). Any breach of such rules or non-adherence to standard etiquette may result in disciplinary action by SBNSW
- Players to mark their own games until referees can be supplied
- Players are asked to please brush and pad the table on completion of their games.
- Players or referees are not permitted to smoke/vape or consume alcohol whilst involved in a game
- Seedings will apply based on the National Snooker Rankings as per the ABSC website.
- Format: Dependant on number of entries., straight knock-out over best of five (5) frames; Final best of seven (7) frames.
- Dress Rules:
 - Fri & Sat: Snooker NSW Polo Shirts or plain Black or White polo Or plain colored long sleeve shirt, with dark tailored trousers, dark colored plain dress shoes & dark coloured socks
 - Sun: Full dress - ie Plain colored long sleeve shirt, with dark tailored trousers, dark colored plain dress shoes dark tailored trousers, dark colored plain dress shoes, dark coloured socks, Waistcoat & Bow Tie.
- Entries will be required online www.snookernsw.com before any player is permitted to compete.
- Locally based players within a 40km radius may be required on Friday night
- Entries may be limited to 71
- Tournament Director may vary tournament conditions.
- Indemnity & Acknowledgement:
 - All participants enter at their own risk. the SBNSW, the venue, the sponsors nor the organisers shall be responsible for any loss, injury or misadventure arising.
