TOURNAMENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

Eligibility: Players who have won any WWS, IBSF, APSBF, Oceania, Australian (exceptions apply), NSW or other State Women's Snooker Championship are ineligible. Past winners of this particular Championship are ineligible as are past winners of similar inter-state 'minor' Women's Snooker Championships;

- As this event is a State Championship all entrants are required to: comply
 with NSW residency criteria; i.e. must be a NSW resident and have been
 permanently domiciled in the State of NSW for a minimum period of six (6)
 months immediately prior to this event;
- Not have previously competed in another State's Championship of the same discipline in the same calendar year;
- The Championship will be played subject to the Rules of Snooker as prescribed by the WPBSA. ABSC Playing Conditions and all matters pertaining to <u>Player's</u> <u>Code of Conduct and Ethics</u> will also be adhered to. Any breach of such rules or non-adherence to standard etiquette may result in disciplinary action being taken against the offenders.
- NOTE: No players or referees are permitted to smoke/vape or consume alcohol
 whilst involved in playing or refereeing a game unless during an official session
 break.
- Tournament standard dress is required:
 - SBNSW Polo shirt or plain black or white polo shirt OR Plain coloured collared dress shirt with sleeves below the elbows; Dark coloured tailored trousers or dark skirt, no shorter than kneecap, ladies dark coloured dress shoes (open or closed toe) shall be worn to all sessions. Waistcoat is optional.
 Failure to comply with these conditions may result in forfeiture of the game.
- Format & prize money will be determined subject to number of entries received.
- Entries & memberships only accepted online & will be required before any player is permitted to compete.
- Players to mark their own games, a room referee will be available. Referees will be provided from the Semi Finals onwards, subject to availability

WOMEN'S DRESS REGULATIONS







POLO SHIRT

SBNSW Offical State Polo shirt OR plain black or white polo

POLO SHIRT

No coloured or patterned polos

No other unapproved logos or graphics - incuding club shirts









DRESS SHIRT

Predominately plain coloured dress shirt/blouse with sleeves below the elbow & with full buttoning down the front & collar suitable for the wearing of a bow tie.

DRESS SHIRT

Shirts/blouses must be clean and ironed, and neatly tucked in where possible.









TROUSERS/SKIRTS

Dark coloured, tailored trousers or dark skirt, no shorter than kneecap. Dark, predominately plain coloured.

TROUSERS

No jeans, cargo pants, or other casual pants/skirts.
Trousers with cuts or rips, or skirts above the knee are not permitted.
No trousers with stitchedon, jeans like, pockets and no metal button closure.









FOOTWEAR

Formal shoes of a style that is befitting whilst wearing a Dress or Lounge suit.

Socks must be in-keeping with the style of suit in terms of length and colour.

Tights and pop socks are permitted. Patterns & coloured socks are permitted

FOOTWEAR

Sport shoes,
trainers/sneakers and,
high boots are not
acceptable.
No dirty or broken/torn
shoes.
White athletic socks are
not permitted.
